What is the primary target of cyber criminals?

Student's Answer:

Cybercriminals primarily target data and money — specifically, personally identifiable information (names, IDs, financial details), corporate financial assets, and access credentials. In terms of volume, individuals are the most frequently targeted (through phishing, identity theft, and fraud), but in terms of financial impact, businesses and organizations are the preferred target because they hold larger sums and richer data, and are more likely to pay ransoms. Critical infrastructure (healthcare, energy, government systems) is an increasingly attractive target too, since disruption creates urgency and leverage for extortion.

Correct Answer:

Personal information and sensitive data.

How can individuals protect themselves from cyber crime?

use strong, passwords or use a password manager; it is always good to enable multi-factor authentication; also it is recommended to keep software and devices updated; try not to click on unknown links or attachments (phishing); avoid the use non-secure networks for example: public Wi-Fi; you can also back up important data regularly; it is always recommended to monitor bank/credit statements for any unknown charges.
