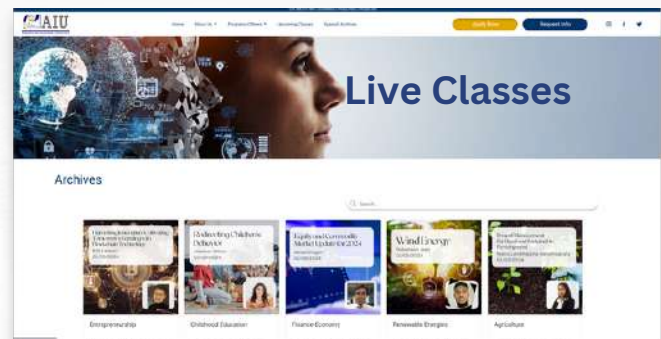

Juniper Research estimates that AI chatbots could save the legal industry over \$1.2 billion annually by 2026, particularly in client intake and customer service.

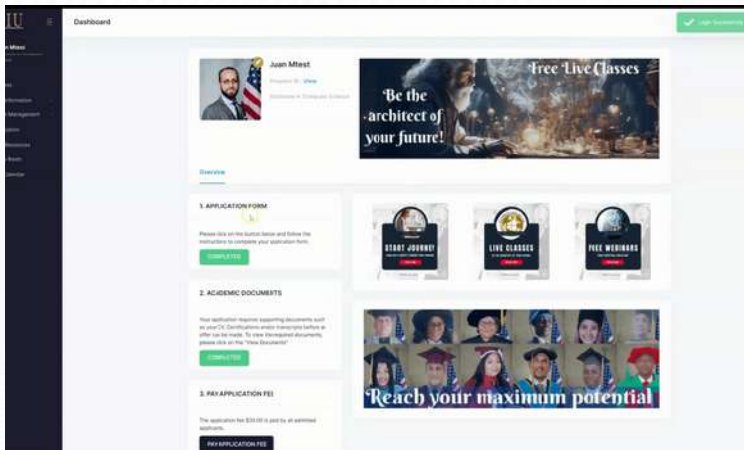
